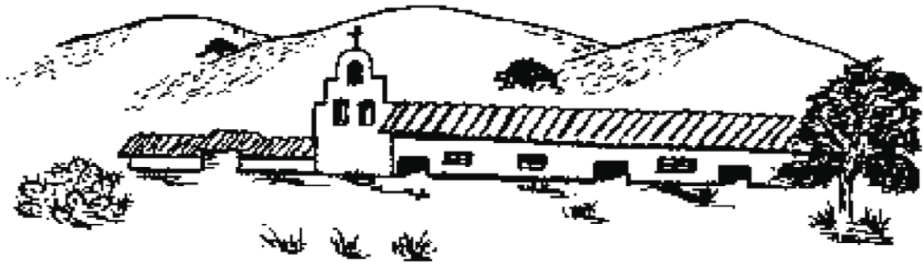

2nd degree, 21 April 2018 at La Purisima Church Hall, hosted by Council 3570

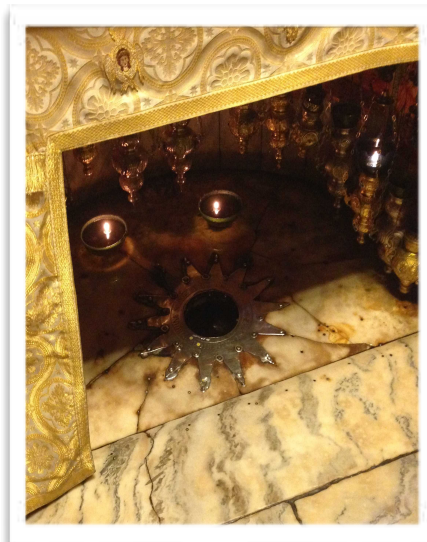
Fifth Sunday Rosary is this Sunday (December 31, 2017) after the 10:00 AM Mass. Join us and pray for vocations and your own intentions.
