

His family asked him to see the doctor, but he said he was okay. Two days later the emergency room doctors couldn't save him. He was 66 years old. I talked with my doctor and

he said he has seen many very sick people. The flu that everyone is catching is a very aggressive strain. Ask your doctor if getting a flu shot this late in the season is beneficial. And be prepared for next season with getting the flu vaccine early. I pray that you will take care of yourselves and see the doctor as soon as you get sick.

Dick McGreevy's March K of C Pro-Life report

This Lent provides us a great opportunity to reflect on what we are doing to promote a Culture of Life in our community. We know our Order is a national leader in the pro-life movement. But what are we, as individual Knights, doing? Here are two suggestions for meaningful action.

First, set aside a little time each week to pray across the street from the local Planned Parenthood abortion clinic. The clinic is located at 415 E. Chapel St., Santa Maria. This simple action will open your eyes to how much pro-life education and action still needs to be done. Once you personally see young teens being led into the clinic by parents or older boyfriends, you'll know that you are not doing enough. Once you see cars with rosaries hanging from the rear view mirrors enter the parking lot, you'll know you need to have "that talk" with your children or grandchildren. Once you see couples having long, tearful talks in the clinic parking lot before entering the clinic, you'll know you need to pray more. Once you see ladies stagger out the clinic doors with tears in their eyes, you'll know you need to help more.

A second Lenten action, even more simple than the first is to call your State Assemblyman, Jordon Cunningham, and ask him to vote NO on Senate Bill 320. SB-320 would require the state's 34 public universities to provide the abortion pill at campus health centers by January, 2022. Cunningham's San Luis Obispo office number is (805) 549-3381. His Sacramento office number is (916) 319-2035. Your call will be answered by an office staffer who will relay your request to the assemblyman. Once you have completed one or both suggested actions, be ready to celebrate the best Easter you have ever experienced.
