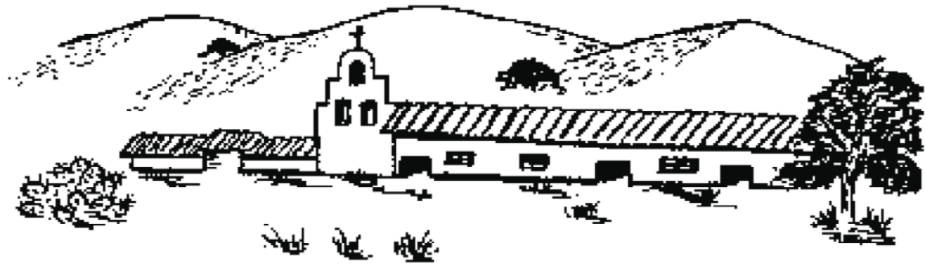

Top Five Reasons for Income Protection

Dear Brothers,
