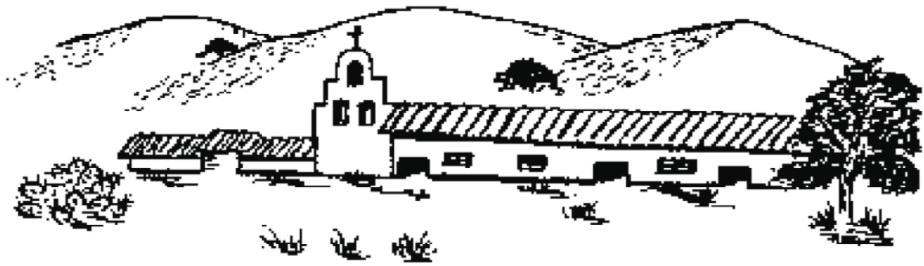

Dear Brother Knights and Guest Readers,

In Sunday's 27 August Gospel Reading (MT 16:13-20), Jesus strictly orders his disciples to tell no one that he was Christ. In our Chaplain's homily, Father Mike said Jesus told the disciples this because Jesus wanted His followers to realize He was Christ on their own in their hearts. You know the rest of the story.
